PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Municipal Code Section 2.36.060 empowers the Director of Emergency Services for the City of San Pablo to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency if the city council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Director does hereby find:

That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen on March 24, 2011, between 12:00 am and 8:00 am, within said City of San Pablo as a result of a landslide between the 5900 block of Hillcrest Road and the 5900 block of Wyman Street, thereby causing major damage to seven properties and threatening and damaging public and private properties in the area of the landslide.

That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency;

WHEREAS, the Director has determined:

Locally available resources are inadequate to cope with the emergency and request that Contra Costa County and the Governor to proclaim a state of emergency.

That the City Council of the City of San Pablo is not in session.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY PROCLAIMED that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the Director of Emergency Services and the emergency organization of the City of San Pablo, Contra Costa County, California, shall be those prescribed by State law, by ordinances and resolutions of the City; and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED the San Pablo City Council shall take action to ratify the proclamation within seven days thereafter or the proclamation shall have no further force or effect.
