As many of you may know, the Wyman/Hillcrest Landslide that occurred last week – March 24th – directly affected several San Pablo homes resulting in extensive damage to residential properties. Not only did this create a major disruption to their day-to-day lives, it also created unexpected financial burdens for the homeowners affected by this tragic event.
